LA DULCINÉE PINOT GRIS 2015

Estate-grown and hand-picked at over 350 metres above sea level, in the La Dulcinée Vineyard at Bendigo, in Central Otago, the 2015 vintage was fermented and lees-aged for a year in stainless steel barriques (85 per cent) and French acacia puncheons (15 per cent). A powerful, very youthful wine, it is full-bodied (14.5 per cent alcohol), with concentrated pear, lychee, peach and spice flavours, a distinct touch of complexity, and a dryish (5.7 grams/litre of residual sugar), lasting finish. Best drinking mid-2017+. Certified organic.
