4.5 Stars & Super Classic

Typically a very classy Nelson red. It is hand-picked from 'older vines' at Upper Moutere, fermented with indigenous yeasts, matured for 10 to 12 months in French oak barriques (25 per cent new in 2014), and usually bottled without fining or filtering. The 2014 vintage has fullish, slightly developed colour. Mouthfilling, savoury and slightly earthy, it has cherry, plum, spice and nut flavours, showing excellent complexity, and a finely textured finish.
