



2014 “EASTSIDE” SHIRAZ

Colour: Medium to deep red.

Aroma: Displaying our typical dark cherry and blueberry fruit with hints of graphite and some subtle spicy notes. Also has a nice touch of charry French oak swirling around in the background.

Palate: The medium bodied palate has layers of cherry/blueberry fruit initially followed by black olive and graphite before some savoury tannins kick in at the end. Just a hint of the charry oak adds some interest as well.

Summary: The Clare Valley does tend to live in the shadow of our southern colleagues in the Barossa and McLaren Vale a little when it comes to Shiraz , but we produce gorgeous medium bodied wines year after year. Delicious to drink now and the next 7 -10 years. Try this with a hearty beef & stout stew.
