RED SHED PINOT BLANC 2015

The classy 2015 vintage was estate-grown and hand-picked at Bendigo, fermented with indigenous yeasts in old French barriques, lees-aged in oak for 10 months, and given a full, softening malolactic fermentation. Pale lemon/green, it is mouthfilling, with concentrated, peachy, citrusy flavours, slightly biscuity and buttery notes adding complexity, and a bone-dry, very long and harmonious finish. A subtle, finely poised, very youthful wine, it should be at its best 2018+.
