Dense and impressively structured pinot noir, with plum and dark cherry flavours that are a little locked in by firm tannins at this early stage. Assertive oak adds extra spice. Powerful wine with plenty of potential. It earns a conservative rating and would almost certainly gain bonus points with bottle age. Drink 2016 to 2026.

At its best, this Central Otago red is mouthfilling and savoury, with superb concentration of sweet-tasting, plummy fruit and lovely harmony. The grapes have been drawn from various sub-regions and vineyards over the years and yields have been very low (under 5 tonnes/hectare). The 2015 vintage was grown at Bendigo and matured for 11 months in French oak barriques (33 per cent new). Deep and youthful in colour, it is powerful, ripe and concentrated, with dense, vibrant plum, spice and nut flavours, earthy notes adding complexity, and obvious potential. Best drinking 2020+.
