Best in Show, Platinum Medal & 97 Points

Very pale amber-orange in colour. Very light, delicate and elegant aromas of preserved orange skins and other citrus zests combined with apricot and peach and a little basmati-rice sweetness. Fragrant and enticing. All of the aromatic allusions swim together on the palate, which has a richer texture than the pungent aromas led one to expect. Deft, hinting at sweetness without ever quite delivering it, and full of refined fruit zest with its bittersweet intrigue, this is a benchmark Palo Cortado in all its enigmatic charm. 2018-2020.
