VINTAGE CONDITIONS

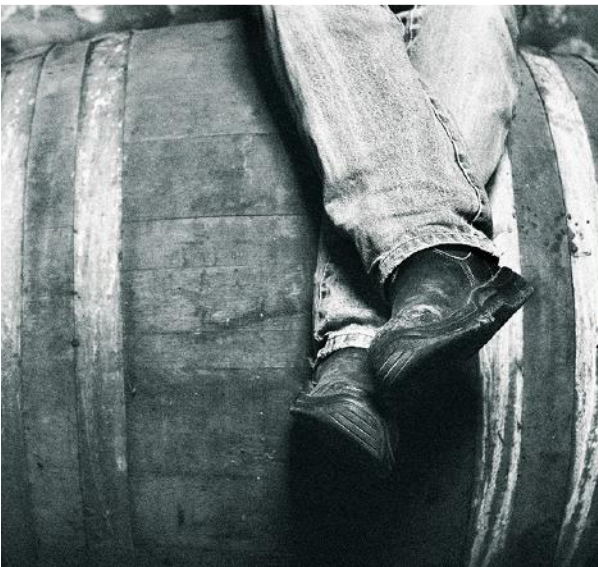
The fruit for this wine was sourced from the Murray Darling and Riverina regions of South Eastern Australia. Each vineyard offers slightly different soils and canopy arrangements. The climate in this region is hot with high evaporation rates and generally low rainfall, making irrigation essential. The climate is also continental, resulting in long sunny days and noticeably cooler nights. Modern viticultural and winemaking techniques mean that the climate can be seen as one of the region's strengths. Long sunshine hours ensure fruit ripens fully and low relative humidity results in little incidence of disease. These conditions delivered a wine with attractive aromas of passionfruit, lemon and lime.

WINEMAKING

To get the best characters out of the Sauvignon Blanc varietal minimal input from the winemaker is necessary. The fruit was harvested in the cool of the night and then crushed so the juice could be clarified prior to fermentation. The fermentation occurred in stainless steel vats where a selected yeast strain was introduced to further enhance the varietal fruit flavours and aromas. Early bottling ensured the natural freshness of this was captured ready to be enjoyed.

TASTING NOTES

A full flavoured Sauvignon Blanc that exhibits superb varietal intensity, a firm acid back bone, while finishing soft and sweet with a good length of flavour. The clean, crisp characters of Sauvignon Blanc make it a perfect accompaniment to lighter style dishes particularly seafood and fresh pasta.
