The 2013 Neil Ashmead Gts Elderton Estate, named after their father, is an estate-grown cuvee from a single block planted in the 1950s and farmed biodynamically since after 2006. Aged in 100% new French oak for 12+ months on the lees, this medium-deep garnet colored Shiraz opens to beautifully lifted black cherry, blackberry and floral notes intermingling with a slightly gamy/meaty undercurrent that has an accent of star anise. The medium to full-bodied palate is structured by fine, grainy tannins and nice freshness that lends great elegance to the long finish.
