One of the most popular Cotes-du-Rhones, this grenache and syrah blend shows lovely elegant style. Fragrant aromas of dark cherry, smoked meat, roasted beet and almond on the nose. The palate shows pristine fruit flavours with subtle savoury complexity, beautifully framed by fine, chalky tannins. An excellent food wine. At its best: now to 2020.
