Wild berry, crushed violet, pipe tobacco and chopped herb aromas leap out of the glass. Smooth and savory, the full-bodied palate shows restraint and elegance, delivering red cherry, pomegranate, ground clove and black pepper alongside taut fine-grained tannins and bright acidity.

It is deeply savoury and gamey with sweet berry/floral overtones. The magnificently complex bouquet reveals dark cherry, leather, smoked wood, thyme and truffle aromas, leading to a finely textured palate that is multi-layered and tantalisingly elegant. This is a compelling rendition of sangiovese showing fabulous maturity and complexity with a persistent refined finish. At its best: now to 2020.
